# 1. Foreword

We offer free one to one career coaching sessions to map out what our clients want for their career, set out actions that get them closer to their goals, and keep them accountable for taking steps toward their goal. We offer workshops that will complement the coaching sessions. Our primary goal is to help our clients to help themselves in as many ways possible.

#### 4. Goals


- a. To become a reference in the Dutch system when it comes to supporting unemployed international professionals to get back into the workforce and being able to contribute to Dutch society.
- b. Increase the number of clients successfully back to work by 50% each year.



# 5. Future Plans

- a. We aim to expand our activities to another two cities in The Netherlands: Den Haag and Utrecht, by the end of 2019.
- b. We want to have our own office space where we can offer free workshops to our clients and also host paid events to gather funds for Empower Amsterdam.
- c. Have 50% of our income coming from sponsoring from big international companies based in Amsterdam.
- d. Develop partnership with learning/government institutions where we can offer training opportunities to our clients in areas of importance and related to the future of the workforce (digital literacy, advanced IT skills etc).
